I have enclosed an Alumnus Delegate Credentials Form which must be submitted by **Wednesday, May 1, 2024**, with the names of your authorized and alternate delegates to the Convention. You may also submit the name of your delegates electronically by visiting thetachi.org/alumnusdelegate.
